<u>Section 2.</u> Section 4 of Local Law No. 3 of the Year 2010 is hereby revised, set forth herein in section 1 of this Local Law, and said section 4, as revised, shall read as follows:

Section 4. Residency Requirements For Village of Lyndonville Clerk-Treasurer, Deputy Clerk-Treasurer, and Superintendent of Public Works.

The persons holding the offices of Clerk-Treasurer, Deputy Clerk-Treasurer and Superintendent of Public Works, for the Village of Lyndonville need not be a resident nor an elector of the Village of Lyndonville, provided, however, that such persons reside in either the Towns of Yates, Ridgeway, Shelby, Gaines or Carlton, said Towns being situate in the County of Orleans, the County (Orleans) in which such Village is located.

Section 3. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
