SECTION 1.

On or before January 1, 1989, every dwelling unit in every one family dwelling, two family dwelling or multiple dwelling unit in the Village of Lyndonville shall have installed therein an operable single-station smoke detecting alarm device or devices. Such device or devices shall be in compliance with the standards and requirements of the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code provided, however, that battery operated devices shall be permitted. The owner of every such dwelling unit shall be responsible for compliance with the requirements of this paragraph.

SECTION 2.

The violation of this Local Law shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars for each violation. Each day any such violation shall continue shall constitute a separate violation.

SECTION 3.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
