A local law AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF GAMES OF CHANCE BY AUTHORIZED ORGANIZATIONS (Insert Title) WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LYNDONVILLE, ORLEANS COUNTY, NEW YORK

Be it enacted by the BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the (Name of Legislative Body)

SECTION 1. This Local Law shall be known as the Games of Chance Law of the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 2. "Village" shall mean the Village of Lyndonville.

"Authorized Organization" shall mean an authorized organization as defined in Paragraph 4 of Section 186 of the General Municipal Law.

"Games of Chance" shall mean a game of chance as defined in Paragraph 3 of Section 186 of the General Municipal Law.

SECTION 3. Authorized organizations may, upon obtaining a license from the Clerk of the Village of Lyndonville, conduct games of chance within the Village of Lyndonville, Orleans County, New York, as provided in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law and as provided further in this Local Law. Such games of chance shall be conducted in accordance with Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law, this Local Law, and the rules and regulations of the New York State Racing and Wagering Board.

SECTION 4. Games of chance on the first day of the week, commonly known as Sunday, may be conducted pursuant to this Local Law and appropriate statute and regulation.

SECTION 5. The powers and duties set forth in Subdivision 1 of Section 194 of the General Municipal Law and any other police control required under Article 9-A of said General Municipal Law shall be exercised by the chief law enforcement officer of the County of Orleans, New York. The chief law enforcement officer of the County of Orleans shall exercise control over and supervision of all games of chance conducted under an appropriately issued license.

SECTION 6. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State's Office, following its approval at referendum by a majority of qualified voters thereon at the General Village Election to be held March 19, 1991, in accordance with the provisions of Section 23 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.


