A local law ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE USE, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF LANDS NOW OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF LYNDONVILLE

SECTION 174-1 APPLICABILITY

The prohibitions, rules and regulations contained in this chapter shall apply to lands now owned by the Village of Lyndonville within the corporate limits of the said Village of Lyndonville which lands were purchased from the Owasco River Railway, Inc. and are commonly known as the Ontario Branch of the former New York Central Railroad Company.

SECTION 174-2 DEFINITIONS

The following terms shall have the meaning herein indicated when used in this chapter:

PROPERTY: Lands acquired by the Village of Lyndonville from the Owasco River Railway, Inc. by a deed recorded in the Orleans County Clerk's Office in Book 509 of Deeds at page 50 commonly known as the Ontario Branch railroad right of way of the former New York Central Railroad Company including Bridge No. 0-85 over Johnson's Creek situate in the corporate limits of the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 174-3 PRESENCE IN PROPERTY

No person shall be or remain within the property at any time from one-half (½) hour after sunset until one-half (½) hour before sunrise the following morning, except if such person has the written permission of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 174-4 SIGNS PROHIBITED

No person shall post or display any sign of any kind within the property.

SECTION 174-5 PEDDLING AND SOLICITING

No person shall engage in any commercial or business activities within the property.

SECTION 174-6 HORSES

No person shall have, ride or lead any horse or pony in the property.

SECTION 174-7 FIRES

No person shall make, kindle or maintain any fire within the property.

SECTION 174-8 DEFACING PROPERTY

No person shall deface, write, paint or carve in or upon any tree, bench, building or structure of any kind or other property located within the property.

SECTION 174-9 WEAPONS AND FIREWORKS

No person shall possess, carry, fire or discharge any gun, pistol, firearm, rocket, torpedo, or fireworks of any description or any bow or arrow or other weapon within the property.

SECTION 174-10 INTERFERENCE WITH PLANTS AND VEGETATION

No person shall cut, dig up, pick or otherwise disturb or remove any bushes, shrubs or trees located within the property.

SECTION 174-11 POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

No person shall consume or possess any alcoholic beverages, including wine or beer, within the property.

SECTION 174-12 LITTERING

No person shall bring into, deposit, leave behind or dump or dispose of any refuse, ashes, garbage or other putrescible materials within the property.

SECTION 174-13 MOTOR VEHICLES

No person shall operate any motor vehicle, including, but not limited to, automobiles, motorcycles, snowmobiles, minibikes, all-terrain vehicles, dirt bikes or any other vehicle within the property.

SECTION 174-14 BRIDGE

No person shall jump from or swing off from the bridge over Johnson's Creek located on the property.

SECTION 174-15 PENALTIES

Any violation of any provisions of this chapter shall constitute a violation pursuant to the Penal Law and any person convicted of a violation of this Local Law shall be subject to a fine not exceeding Two Hundred Fifty and 00/100 (\$250.00) Dollars or by imprisonment for terms not exceeding fifteen (15) days, or by both such fine or imprisonment.

SECTION 174-16 EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Department of State.
