SECTION 164-1 TITLE

This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the Village of Lyndonville Parks Local Law.

SECTION 164-2 APPLICABILITY

The prohibitions, rules and regulations contained in this chapter shall apply to all parks and public lands and facilities devoted or used for recreational or similar purposes owned, leased or otherwise under the control, supervision and jurisdiction of the Village of Lyndonville, New York.

SECTION 164-3 DEFINITIONS

Park - The grounds, buildings thereon, waters therein and any other property used in connection therewith or constituting a part hereof which is now or may hereafter be owned, leased, used, maintained, operated or controlled by the Village of Lyndonville for recreational and sports activities.

Person - Any individual, firm, partnership, corporation or association of persons, and when the singular form is used, it shall include the plural.

Vehicle - Every device or conveyance in, upon or by which a person or property is or may be transported or drawn, and shall include motor vehicles as defined in the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 164-4 PRESENCE IN PROPERTY

No person shall be or remain within any Village park at any time from sunset until sunrise the following morning, except if such person has the written permission of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lyndonville or if the Board of Trustees has adopted a resolution granting such permission.

SECTION 164-5 SIGNS PROHIBITED

No person shall post or display any sign of any kind within any park in the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 164-6 PEDDLING AND SOLICITING

No person shall engage in any commercial or business activities within any park except if such person has the written permission of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lyndonville, signed by the Mayor or Deputy Mayor of the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 164-7 HORSES

No person shall have, ride or lead any horse or pony in any park in the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 164-8 FIRES

No person shall make, kindle or maintain any fire within any park in the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 164-9 DEFACING PROPERTY

No person shall deface, write, paint or carve in or upon any tree, bench, building or structure of any kind or other property located within any park in the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 164-10 WEAPONS AND FIREWORKS

No person shall possess, carry, fire or discharge any gun, pistol, firearm, rocket, torpedo, or fireworks of any description or any bow or arrow or other weapon within any park in the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 164-11 INTERFERENCE WITH PLANTS AND VEGETATION

No person shall cut, dig up, pick or otherwise disturb or remove any bushes, shrubs or trees located within any park in the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 164-12 POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

No person shall consume or possess any alcoholic beverages, including wine or beer, within any park in the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 164-13 LITTERING

No person shall bring into, deposit, leave behind or dump or dispose of any refuse, ashes, garbage or other putrescible materials within any park in the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 164-14 MOTOR VEHICLES

No person shall operate any motor vehicle, including, but not limited to, automobiles, motorcycles, snowmobiles, minibikes, all-terrain vehicles, dirt bikes or any other vehicle within any park in the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 164-15 INTERFERENCE WITH WILDLIFE PROHIBITED

No person shall hunt, disturb or molest any birds or animals in any parks in the Village of Lyndonville, and no person shall rob or molest any bird's nest or take any eggs of any bird in any park in the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION 164-16 PENALTIES

Any violation of any provisions of this chapter shall constitute a violation pursuant to the Penal Law and any person convicted of a violation of this Local law shall be subject to a fine not exceeding Two Hundred Fifty and 00/100 (\$250.00) Dollars or by imprisonment for terms not exceeding fifteen (15) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 164-17 EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Department of State.
