A local law Extending the Moratorium on the Placement of Single-Wide

SECTION I. PURPOSE.

The Village of Lyndonville heretofore enacted Local Law No. 4 of the Year 1997 providing for a one-year moratorium on the placement of single-wide mobile homes within the Village so that the current regulations in effect could be reviewed and altered if needed. The termination date of the said Local Law is July 18, 1998. The Planning Board of the Village of Lyndonville has conducted a study and meetings in order to develop proper and reasonable regulations and is finalizing the text of a proposed amendment to the Village Code regarding this subject matter. In order to allow the Planning Board to complete its work and to further allow the Village Board to properly and duly consider the necessity and desirability, if any, of an amendment to the Village Code with respect to reasonable and appropriate regulations relative to single-wide mobile homes, it is hereby determined to be in the best interests of the Village of Lyndonville to extend the said moratorium for an additional period of ninety days.

SECTION II. MORATORIUM EXTENDED.

Upon the enactment of this Local Law and the filing thereof with the Secretary of State as required by law, the moratorium created and established by Local Law No. 4 of the Year 1997 of the Village of Lyndonville shall continue for an additional period of ninety (90) days. The termination date of this Local Law may not be extended by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lyndonville except by further Local Law duly enacted.

SECTION III. EFFECT OF MORATORIUM.

The effect of the moratorium shall be as is fully set forth in Section III of Local Law No. 4 of the Year 1997 of the Village of Lyndonville.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Local Law and the moratorium hereby extended shall take effect upon the expiration date of the aforementioned Local Law No. 4 of the Year 1997 and upon the due filing of this Local Law with the Secretary of State as required by Law.
