• Amend – Local Law 2020-2 – Sewer Use Law Update

#### **Article XVIII Charges**

#### § 190-132. Sewage Service Charges

C. Sewer use charges which are not paid on or before the due date shall bear a penalty of ten five percent (%). When sewer user charges are not paid within thirty (30) days of the due date, an additional five percent (5%) of the amount thereof shall be added thereto and collected thereafter. All sewer user charges not paid subsequent to the termination of water service shall have a penalty of two percent (2%) per month of the amount due and owing added thereto from the date of termination and collected thereafter. If such amount remains unpaid on the first day of June, the Village Clerk- Treasurer shall certify the amount due and payable to the Village Board, which shall levy the same as taxes and add such sewer user charge and penalties to the succeeding tax roll of the Village. Such tax shall be collected and enforced in the same manner and at the same time as provided for the collection and enforcement of the Village taxes, and it shall be the duty of the Village Clerk-Treasurer to charge and collect interest thereon at the same rate specified for the collection of Village taxes. Such sewer user charges shall constitute a lien upon the real property served by the POTW, and such lien shall be prior and superior to any other lien or claim except the lien of an existing tax, assessment or other lawful charge.
